REACH/ RoHS¹ – Declaration

according to

- EU Directive 1907/2006/EC for the registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemicals (REACH), article 33
- RoHS according to EU Directive 2011/65/EC (RoHS II)
- The ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) Candidate List of substances of very high concern (SVHC)

For the purpose of REACH regulations, the ggp Schaltungen Company in Osterode (Germany) is considered a downstream user. The company manufactures PCBs (printed circuit boards) and delivers to you non-chemical products exclusively. Consequently, no substances should be released from the product under rationally predictable conditions of use. Therefore and on principle, the ggp Schaltungen Company is not subject to mandatory registration and submission of material safety data sheets (MSDSs).


We are dedicated to ensuring high product safety standards for our customers and therefore intensely monitor the Reach compliance of our suppliers. We vigorously communicate this to our suppliers of chemicals and formulations such as raw materials, auxiliary materials, and consumables for use in our manufacturing, processing, and miscellaneous operating processes.


We request a signed binding '**Supplier Compliance and Conformity Declaration**' from our suppliers, which states whether any of their delivered products contain more than 0.1 percent by weight of the substances listed in the ECHA Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern.

In the event we should receive information from our suppliers to the effect that supplied goods contain substances mentioned in the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern as amended and providing these substances exceed the threshold value of 0.1 percent by weight in our products, we will immediately and without being prompted comply with our statutory reporting duty pursuant to REACH, Article 33 and will report this upon delivery of the respective goods.

We assure that we will put in place all necessary organisational measures to ensure compliance after implementing REACH. As of today and according to the information obtained from our suppliers, we do not expect our products to contain more than 0.1 percent by weight of the Substances of Very High Concern, which are compiled in the Candidate List as amended and valid until 17th December 2014.

We made the above declaration to the best of our knowledge according to the current state of the art and based on applicable laws and regulations as amended. Even though the ggp Schaltungen Company in Osterode (Germany) considers the information in the above declaration reliable and correct, we do not guarantee or assume liability for the accuracy and completeness of the information.
